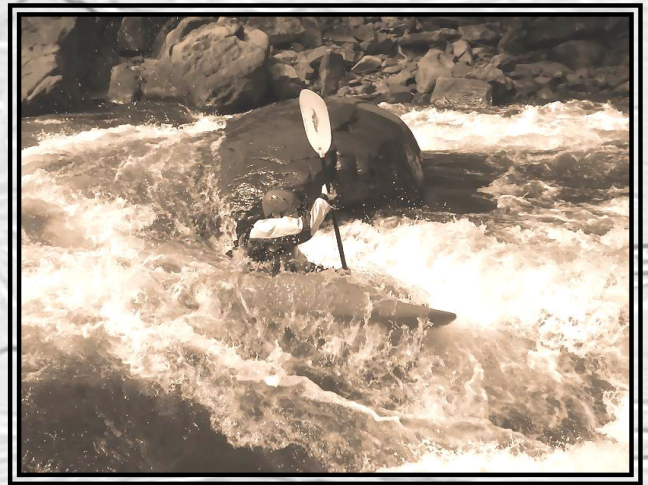
## Ever want to kayak, canoe, or raft?
